2 A modern look for a traditional house. Materials include custom walnut cabinets with a honed black granite countertop and backsplash. A custom steel, wood and stainless island features a downdraft cooktop. Large honed limestone tiles are used for the flooring.

3 A contemporary kitchen for a light-filled, open plan urban loft. Design details include a stainless steel countertop with monolithic full height backsplash and display shelf. Custom wall-mounted frosted glass-fronted cabinets and locally harvested wide plank pine floors.
